

RENEW YOUR MEMBERSHIP

You will receive an email from the Society of Camera Operator via our membership database Joinit.org.

There are four different types of emails that go out to remind you of your membership dues.

Non-Automatic Payments – Members who will receive various emails notifying them of their expiring membership. They will need to log into their membership page to manually pay their dues.

1. 30 days prior to your membership expiring you will receive your first email notifying you of your upcoming membership dues expiration.
 - a. [Society of Camera Operators] Time to renew your Membership – 30 Days
2. 7 days prior to your membership expiring you will receive your second email notifying you of your upcoming membership dues expiration.
 - a. [Society of Camera Operators] Time to renew your Membership – 7 Days
3. 2 days prior to your membership expiring you will receive your third email notifying you of your upcoming membership dues expiration.
 - a. [Society of Camera Operators] Time to renew your Membership – 2 Days
4. The day after your membership has expired you will receive a fourth email notifying you of your expired membership.
 - a. [Society of Camera Operators] Your membership has expired – Renewal steps inside.

Listed below are the various three emails that you will receive until the membership has renewed.

Whether you receive a 30 day, 7 day or 2 day notification the process to renew is the same.


